SANITATION.

There is a buildup of brown scale, stains, fly dirt, and debris on the sides and floor of plastic guinea pig enclosures. The regular cleaning process (method and frequency) utilized is not effective in removing this accumulation of scale, stains, dirt, and debris. Failure to effectively clean and sanitize enclosures exposes the animals to potential disease hazards such as bacterial, fungal, and viral diseases. Primary enclosures must be cleaned often enough to prevent an accumulation of scale, stains, dirt, and debris and must be sanitized at least once every two weeks. Correct by ensuring that all primary enclosures are kept clean to prevent an accumulation of scale, stains, dirt, and debris and the that enclosures are sanitized at least once every two weeks. Correct by March 19, 2016.

SANITATION.

Housekeeping. The floor contains shavings, hay, dirt, and debris. There is a dust, dirt, debris, and clutter on the upper shelf in the back corner of the building. There is empty bags on the floor in the front corner. Cobwebs are accumulating on the windows, ceiling and walls. Correct by ensuring the premises are kept clean, including: removing accumulations of dust, cobwebs, hay, shavings, and bags; routinely dusting off and sanitizing all surfaces in the inside of the facility; and cleaning off the shelf in back corner. Correct by March 19, 2016.
