#### SANITATION.

There is brown scale buildup on the sides of floors of the guinea pig enclosures. Brown scale buildup exposes the guinea pigs to potential infections with bacteria, fungi, and parasites. Correct by ensuring that primary enclosures are cleaned and sanitized often enough to prevent a buildup of brown scale. Additionally, ensure that the primary enclosures are sanitized once every two weeks. Correct by May 20, 2017.
