Primary enclosures.

There is an accumulation of cleaning supplies, a brush, gloves, and a water bowl on top of the weaned guinea pig enclosure. These items are causing the top of the enclosure to bow and become unstable. Primary enclosures that are not structurally sound could cause injury to the animals if the top were to collapse. The accumulation of items or the animals must be moved to protect the guinea pigs from injury.

Watering.

A majority of the primary enclosures have open water bowls which are contaminated with fecal material and bedding. Additionally, several of the water bowls have areas of chew damage making it difficult to clean and sanitize the receptacles properly. Failure to clean water containers and provide potable water can lead to the spread of disease and create a reluctance to drink. Open containers used for dispensing water to guinea pigs shall be placed in or attached to the primary enclosure as to minimize contamination from excreta. The water receptacles must be cleaned, sanitized, and maintained in a way which will minimize contamination with feces and bedding.
