2.40(b)(2) Attending Veterinarian and adequate veterinary care (dealers and exhibitors)

*** 3 animals were found in need of veterinary care during the inspection. This included:

- ~ Animal 1: In the Hut, in the top bin, the fifth row from the door, a white textile guinea pig with brown /grey markings was observed closing the right eye, with a crusty discharge between the upper and lower lid.
- ~ Animal 2: One long haired male Syrian Hamster, tan with white markings, was being housed in an enclosure with a female in Room 18, third rack from the back of the room, fourth row from the top, the 11th cage from the end. This animal was observed with significant hair loss and numerous scabs along the back half of its body. There was a bloody open wound involving the end of the tail to the upper margin of the anal opening. The facility representative stated that this was likely bites from the other hamster and separated them when identified by APHIS Officials.
- ~ Animal 3: One tan and white short haired male Syrian Hamster was being housed in a enclosure with a female in Room 18, ninth rack from back of the room, fourth row from the top, 13th cage from the end. This animal was observed with thinning hair on the back half of its body, and a wound below the tail to the upper margin on the anal area. There was scabbing on the wound margins which is evidence of healing. The facility representative stated that this was likely bites from the other hamster and separated them when identified by APHIS Officials.

These animals were provided adequate veterinary care after being identified by APHIS officials during this inspection.

Correct by ensuring proper veterinary care is provided to all animals showing signs of illness or injury. Appropriate diagnosis and treatment of all animals is necessary to ensure humane care.

The inspection was conducted on February 29 - March 1, 2016. The exit briefing was conducted on March 2, 2016 with the Vice President of the facility; Keri Lupo, VMO; and Mary Geib, VMO.
