Cleaning, sanitization, housekeeping, and pest control.

The primary enclosures in the outdoor housing area are not being sufficiently cleaned. A primary enclosure housing 2 adult Welsh Pembroke Corgis was observed with too numerous to count piles of excreta throughout the enclosure. Additionally, a primary enclosure housing a single adult Welsh Pembroke Corgi was observed with too numerous to count piles of excreta in the northeastern corner of the enclosure. The excreta observed in the primary enclosures varied in appearance from fresh to frozen solid.

Failure to remove excreta from primary enclosures daily can result in an accumulation of feces which can lead to increased disease hazards, discomfort for the animals, increased odors, and/or attract unwanted pests. Excreta and other waste must be removed from primary enclosures daily to prevent an excessive accumulation of feces, to prevent soiling of the dogs contained in the primary enclosures, and to reduce disease hazards, insects, pests, and odors.

Veterinary care for dogs.

The facility does not have the names of treatments, nor the dates of administration recorded in the medical records. While reviewing medical records for vaccines there was a 5-month-old Maltese female (Microchip #4092) found to not have a current medical record for the administration of the 7-way vaccine. The program of veterinary care prescribes that juvenile dogs should be administered a 7-way (DAPP/Leptospirosis) vaccine at 9, 12, and 15 weeks of age. When inquiring with the facility representative on the vaccine status of this dog the representative stated the 7-way vaccines were administered as prescribed, but he forgot to document it on a medical record.

Failure to record the names and dates for all treatments administered does not allow for APHIS officials to determine if adequate veterinary care has been provided for the animals at the facility. The licensee must ensure that the names of all vaccines and treatments administered, and the dates of administration are recorded and maintained for review by APHIS officials.
