##### Veterinary care for dogs.

The facility is not following the written Program of Veterinary Care (PVC):

- The PVC states to administer a Bordetella vaccine annually for adult dogs, the facility is not administering this vaccine to adults.
- The PVC states to administer Neopar vaccine for puppies at 4 weeks of age, the facility is not administering this vaccination.
- The PVC states to administer Distemper and Parvovirus vaccinations annually to adults. For adult female Pug (#1332), adult female Golden Retriever (#1887), Adult female Miniature Schnauzer (#1411), adult female Corgi (#1548), and adult female Corgi (#1541), these animals last received the Distemper and Parvovirus vaccines on 12/2/2023. Additionally, adult male Cavalier King Charles Spaniel (#0548) last received the Distemper and Parvovirus vaccines on 9/6/2024.
- Approximately 20% of puppies receive a Bordetella vaccination at 5 weeks of age, the PVC does not authorize this vaccine for puppies.
- The PVC states to administer a Neopar vaccine at 4 weeks and a Distemper/Parvovirus vaccine at 6 weeks. A litter of 6 Cavalier King Charles Spaniels (#5131, 5120, 5130, 5134, 5140, and 5141) did not receive their first vaccines until they were approximately 8 weeks old.

Failure to administer required vaccines in accordance with a veterinary approved schedule may result in animals to not be adequately protected against disease and/or can cause pain and distress. Correct by ensuring all animals are vaccinated in accordance with the schedule approved by the Attending Veterinarian and contact the Attending Veterinarian to review records and create a plan to determine when to administer future vaccinations for the applicable animals.

#### 3.13(b)(4)

##### Veterinary care for dogs.

The facility was unable to provide documentation of fecal tests performed last year. The facility stated that fecal tests for adults were performed last year in accordance with the schedule in the Program of Veterinary Care but they could not provide the test results. Failure to document testing results may interfere with the ability of APHIS officials to determine if the animals are receiving adequate veterinary care. Medical records must be maintained and include the dates and
