ATTENDING VETERINARIAN AND ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE (DEALERS AND EXHIBITORS).

In pen number 6 is a predominately black guinea pig with hair loss over her hind end. The hair loss is extensive from her stifle downward, especially on the right side.

In pen 22 is a black, brown, and white guinea pig that is breathing shallow and rapidly. She appears thin and doesn't move as quickly as the other guinea pigs in the pen.

In pen 24 is a white, brown, and black guinea pig with discharge around her left eye. The eye is partially closed and the thick yellowish discharge has accumulated in the corner of the eye. The eye appears hazy.

These guinea pigs require veterinary care for their health and well being. Licensee must use appropriate methods to prevent, control, diagnose and treat diseases and injuries. These animals must be examined by a licensed veterinarian for diagnosis and treatment. Documentation of the veterinarian's assessment, treatment, and plan shall be maintained for examination by APHIS officials

This was a focused inspection to address findings from CFR 2.40 (b)(2) on the last inspection dated June 16, 2016. The fifteen or more guinea pigs identified on the previous inspection have been removed from the colony.
