**ATTENDING VETERINARIAN AND ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE (DEALERS AND EXHIBITORS).**

At the previous inspection on May 16, 2017, eight guinea pigs were identified in need of veterinary care. At that time two juvenile guinea pigs were unable to rise, breathing rapid & shallow. They were intermittently twitching or paddling their feet. Licensee called the attending veterinarian (AV) requesting an emergency visit so these two guinea pigs could be humanely euthanized. The AV did not arrive that day or the next. The two juvenile guinea pigs did not receive any supportive care and eventually died. These guinea pigs experienced prolonged suffering. Licensee must establish and maintain a program of adequate veterinary care that includes the availability of emergency care.

Remains Uncorrected

The remaining six guinea pigs were not examined by the attending veterinarian but are being treated as directed via phone discussion with the AV
