At least five dogs that were retained for use as breeding stock were not identified as required by regulation.

Use of an approved method of identification, such as an official tag or microchip, is necessary for many reasons including to assure proper care, treatment and handling of dogs by facility personnel and ancillary personnel, such as the attending veterinarian.

All dogs must be properly identified, such as by use of collars and official tags as the facility presently uses for identification.
