Attending veterinarian and adequate veterinary care (dealers and exhibitors).

On March 30th, 2026, two VMOs observed the following animals in indoor enclosures:

- A young brown and white rabbit appeared lethargic. The VMOs observed the rabbit had a very poor body condition (the spine and ribs could be felt and little muscle was present). It did not react when the inspector touched it and was weak when picked up by an employee. Diarrhea was visible around its tail. The inspection was paused so that the rabbit could receive prompt treatment.
- Another young grey long-haired rabbit in an adjacent cage appeared to have similar signs. The animal was quiet, but responsive, and was thin. Fecal staining was present on its fur and rear end.
- One adult parakeet was observed in the wellness room under observation for abnormal feathering, but was not receiving any treatments. The parakeet was standing on the bottom of the cage, leaning forward. He was not able to walk without using his beak to pull him forward.
- One adult cockatiel was observed in the quarantine room with similar symptoms. He was observed fluffed up at the bottom of the cage and leaning forward, resting on his ankles instead of his feet. He was able to walk several steps but appeared unbalanced.

The inspectors observed records demonstrating the facility had completed their morning daily observations before the inspection. The facility had not observed or identified these conditions before the inspection. These observed animals were not receiving any treatments or special care relative to their medical conditions.

Failing to perform daily observation of all animals and identify these conditions in a timely manner has prevented these animals from receiving timely veterinary care.

The facility took measures to initiate treatment on these animals during the inspection. These animals' conditions must be communicated to and receive evaluation from a veterinarian. The facility must ensure a method of daily observation of all animals to assess their health and well-being. The facility must ensure a mechanism for direct and frequent communication to the attending veterinarian so that timely and accurate information on problems of animal health, behavior, and well-being is conveyed.
