Attending veterinarian and adequate veterinary care (dealers and exhibitors).

-A female teddy/mix tag #3256 had a physical exam on 3/16/2026 and an eye ulcer noted on her right eye and treatment instructions from the Attending Veterinarian (AV) to apply triple antibiotic ophthalmic ointment. The licensee said that the AV left the ophthalmic ointment that day and the eye needed to be treated, however has not been applying the treatment. The affected eye has a small area of cloudiness with small veins in the middle of the cloudy area which can be a sign that it has not fully healed. Not starting treatment for an eye condition per the attending veterinarian's treatments could cause discomfort in an eye and could cause it to get worse.

-A male red poodle tag #3228 had a physical exam on 3/16/2026 and noted that ears are dirty and inflamed and need to be cleaned with the ear cleaner solution at the kennel. The licensee said that the ears have not yet been cleaned as instructed. The ears observed today had a dark material in both and a slight bad odor to them. Not following the attending veterinarian's instructions on ear treatments can cause discomfort and the problem might not improve without treatment.

Ensure to give treatments as instructed by the attending veterinarian and to communicate with the AV if there are questions on treatment instructions.

3.11(c)

Cleaning, sanitization, housekeeping, and pest control.

Various pieces of construction trash (insulation, tin) were scattered under the building and when grass and plants start growing can create areas for rodent nesting and make it difficult to cut the grass/weeds. Rodent nesting areas can increase risk of disease for animals. To protect the health of the animals, the premises must be kept free of accumulations of trash, junk, waste products, and discarded matter.

This is a 1st Re-License Inspection for a Class A license. The inspection and exit briefing were conducted with the applicant.

All items must be in compliance within 2 more inspections or by 5/27/2026 or applicant will forfeit the license fee and must wait 6 months to reapply. Please contact your inspector to schedule your next Re-License Inspection.
