2.40(a)(1)

Attending veterinarian and adequate veterinary care (dealers and exhibitors).

Facility representatives expressed that the attending veterinarian's regular visits do not typically include all of the ratites and pheasants and the written program of veterinary care (PVC) did not have birds on it and does not describe provisions in place to maintain an adequate program of veterinary care for birds at the facility. Lack of a written PVC that addresses the care for birds does not ensure that adequate veterinary care is in place. Ensure that a written program of veterinary care is developed with the attending veterinarian that addresses birds and is in place and is approved by the attending veterinarian.

3.153(a)(1)(i)

Primary enclosures.

The outdoor building that houses Satyr tragopans, peach pheasants, and an Impeyan pheasant, and doves has timber nails that stick out of the pole frame 1-2 inches up by the roof. This is an area where pheasants could possibly contact when flying or jumping up to their highest roosts. Sharp points such as nail points could injure animals. Ensure enclosures are free from any sharp points.

3.154(c)(1)

Environment enhancement to promote psychological well-being.

The approved environmental enrichment plans for ratites and pheasants do not contain special considerations for nestlings, chicks and fledglings to be raised at the facility. Special attention to environment as directed by the attending veterinarian for nestlings, fledglings and chicks is important to ensure that these young animals are kept and raised in an optimal environment for health and development. Ensure that the written program(s) of environmental enhancement address the special considerations as required.

This is a 1st Re-License Inspection for a Class B license. The inspection and exit briefing were conducted with the applicant.

All items must be in compliance within 2 more inspection by 7/12/2026 or the applicant will forfeit the license fee and must wait 6 months to reapply. Please contact your inspector to schedule your next Re-License Inspection.
