Primary enclosures.

Six puppies were in an enclosure that measured 44.25 inches by 72 inches for a total of 3,186 square inches of space. The six puppies measured 19 inches, 20 inches, 20 inches, 21 inches, 21 inches, and 23 inches respectively. Together these six puppies required 4,276 square inches of space. The enclosure they were in was short by 1,090 square inches of space.

Cage space requirements ensure that the dogs have enough room to move about freely within their enclosures. It minimizes the dogs from stepping or sitting in their feces or urine and also minimizes the spread of disease. The licensee must ensure that all enclosures containing dogs and puppies have enough floor space to meet the minimum floor space requirements for the number of and the size of the dogs in that enclosure.

Veterinary care for dogs.

A complete physical exam from head to tail for each dog has not been completed by the Attending Veterinarian since December 2021. Not having the Attending Veterinarian conduct complete physical exams on all dogs at least once every

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12 months doesn't ensure the dogs are being adequately evaluated for health care issues. The Attending Veterinarian must conduct a physical examination of each dog in the kennel. Correct by 5/6/23.

3.13(b)(3)

Veterinary care for dogs.

The licensee stated he vaccinated all adult dogs for distemper and parvo in September of 2022, but he has no documentation showing that. In addition, he believes most of the adult dogs have been vaccinated for rabies, but was unable to find any certificates or documentation showing when they had been vaccinated. Not keeping proper medical records showing documentation of which vaccines were given and the dates they were given doesn't ensure the dogs are properly protected against the various diseases those vaccines are supposed to protect against. The licensee must keep records showing the vaccine type that was given and the date it was given for all dogs in the kennel. Correct starting on 4/6/23.

This inspection and exit interview were conducted with the licensee.
