##### Facilities, general.

The facility has an assortment of excess stored equipment taking up a portion of the bird housing area next to the bird primary enclosure and there is an excessive amount of accumulation of spilled feed outside of the bird primary enclosure at the base. Equipment stored in animal areas could accumulate dust and dirt and act as hiding places for vermin, spilled feed could attract pests and vermin. Animal and food storage areas inside of housing facilities must be kept neat and free of excess equipment and spilled feed to ensure the animal area is maintained free of pests and vermin that may contaminate feed and affect the overall health and well-being of the birds. Eliminate the excess equipment and accumulation of feed and maintain a neat and free from clutter bird housing area. Correct by: 25 September 2023.

#### 3.154

##### Environment enhancement to promote psychological well-being.

An environmental enhancement plan approved by the attending veterinarian that documents the appropriate provisions to provide enrichment and special considerations for birds has not been established by the facility. Failure to establish and maintain an environmental enhancement plan can result in birds not receiving adequate enrichment which can lead to behavioral, social, health, and other psychological problems. Establish, maintain and follow an environment enhancement plan approved by the attending veterinarian to promote the psychological well-being of the birds. Correct by: 2 October 2023
