#### HOUSING FACILITIES, GENERAL.

The cabin building used to house 5 capuchins during the summer months has windows behind panel fencing trimmed with wood. The wood has not been sealed and is not impervious to moisture. The wood trim will absorb water and other liquids, such as urine. Unsealed wood is not in a condition that can be readily sanitized since wood will absorb liquids. Absorption of liquids creates a possible biological hazard that may affect the health of the animals. Place the wood trim in a condition that can be readily sanitized. Correct by: 1 July 2014.
