HOUSING FACILITIES, GENERAL.

In both rooms the dog enclosures are constructed of metal bars. The metal is showing excessive rusting throughout all the enclosures. The rust causes pitting and flaking of the metal and cannot be properly cleaned and sanitized. All rusty metal needs to be replaced or altered in a manner that allows for proper cleaning and sanitization of the metal every two weeks.

HOUSING FACILITIES, GENERAL.

In the room housing the adult dogs, there are two enclosures, containing a total of three dogs, along the back wall that have damage to their wire flooring. The wire has broken and twisted upward towards the dogs. These sharp points pose an injury risk to the dogs. All sharp points must be removed or altered in a manner that eliminates the injury risk to the dogs and the licensee must establish a maintenance plan for the enclosures to ensure they remain safe for the dogs and in good repair.

PRIMARY ENCLOSURES.

In the room housing adult dogs, the enclosure flooring is raised off the ground and constructed of wire. In one enclosure, containing one dog, the wire floor has a hole in it that is approximately three inches wide. All flooring must be constructed in a manner that does not allow for the dog's feet and legs to pass through. The flooring needs to be replaced or altered in a manner that protects the dogs from injury and the licensee must establish a maintenance plan for the enclosure flooring to ensure it remains safe for the dogs and in good repair.

CLEANING, SANITIZATION, HOUSEKEEPING, AND PEST CONTROL.

In the last enclosure in the puppy room, hard water mineral has built up on some of the metal bars. In the room housing the adult dogs, the first enclosure has hard water mineral buildup on the automatic waterer. This buildup of hard water mineral does not allow for proper cleaning and sanitization of the metal bars or the automatic waterer. This buildup of hard water minerals must be removed in order for cleaning and sanitization of these areas every two weeks.
