**2.40(b)(2) Repeat**

**Attending veterinarian and adequate veterinary care (dealers and exhibitors).**

Inside the shelter building there was medication that had expired. There was a bottle of Injectable Bimectin (ivermectin) that expired in June 2025. The use of expired medication is not considered to be a safe or appropriate method to prevent, control, diagnose, and treat disease and injuries because expired drugs may be ineffective or produce other undesired effects. Animals may experience discomfort or distress due to unrelieved symptoms or unexpected side effects from the use of expired medication. The facility must ensure all medications in the kennel are not expired.

**2.50(a)(2) Repeat**

**Time and method of identification.**

The licensee is not properly identifying puppies who are less than 16 weeks old. Seven puppies approximately 2.5 months old from two separate litters did not have any form of identification. Appropriate identification of dogs is necessary to meet record keeping requirements for inventory, disposition, transport and healthcare documentation. The licensee must properly identify puppies with an acceptable form of identification, which includes a cage card (if litter are not comingled), a microchip, a collar and tag, or a plastic-type collar with required information legibly written.
