RECORDS: DEALERS AND EXHIBITORS.

The licensee recently donated three adults dogs without documenting that transaction with an APHIS form 7006. Accurate and complete records are essential to track the movement of dogs. Dogs and puppies that are sold, donated or transferred from the facility must be properly documented and maintained on the APHIS form 7006, Record of Disposition of Dogs and Cats. Correct with next disposition.

3.1(a)

HOUSING FACILITIES, GENERAL.

The wood above the dog egress door of one whelping enclosure is jagged with wooden points sticking into the door opening. This jagged edge could cause injury to the dog in this enclosure as she enters and exits this enclosure. All surfaces must be constructed and maintained in good repair to protect the animals from injury. Correct by 20 April 2016.

3.1(c)(1)(1) REPEAT

HOUSING FACILITIES, GENERAL.

One lower metal support pipe beneath one dog shelter in the east side of the kennel is rusted to the point that sections are missing.

Also, there are holes in the metal walls of the whelping enclosures. These holes are trapping wood shavings and other debris.

Rusted surfaces cannot be adequately cleaned and sanitized and can affect the structural strength of the material. All surfaces must be constructed in a manner that allows them to be readily cleaned and sanitized and remain structurally sound.

3.9(b)

FEEDING.

There are two metal "self-feeders" that have a buildup of food residue and grime on the interior in contact with the food. Dirty food receptacles can contaminate the food and affect the nutritive value of the food. If self-feeders are

used, the licensee must keep them clean and sanitized in accordance with 3.11 b. To be corrected by 13 April 2016.

3.11(a)

CLEANING, SANITIZATION, HOUSEKEEPING, AND PEST CONTROL.

Excreta covered a large portion (approximately a third of the floor space) of the outdoor section of one sheltered whelping enclosures. According to the owner, this enclosure was cleaned 2 days ago. Accumulation of excreta can soil the dogs, increase disease transmission, and attract flies and other pests. Excreta and food waste must be removed from primary enclosures on a daily basis. To be corrected by 7 April 2016.
