ATTENDING VETERINARIAN AND ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE (DEALERS AND EXHIBITORS).

* The following medication spray was past the labeled expiration date. There was one 16 fluid oz. bottle of Vetericyn wound and infection treatment with an expiration date of 06/2012. This spray medication was intermingled with other products that are currently being used at the facility and are therefore ready for use. The usage of expired medical materials such as drugs, fluids, or sutures on regulated animals is not considered to be an acceptable veterinary practice and does not constitute adequate veterinary care. The effectiveness of the dosage level and expected results when expired drugs are administered to dogs could be drastically changed or may not work as anticipated. The licensee must ensure that all medications used are not expired and labeled properly in accordance with standard veterinary practices. Correct by 4/28/15.

HOUSING FACILITIES, GENERAL.

* Two dug holes were observed in the dirt ground floor directly under the enclosure fencing. Five dogs are in contact with the affected areas located in outdoor housing. One hole was estimated to be one foot wide by six inches deep. The second hole was estimated to be two inches wide by three inches deep. This affects the ability of enclosure fencing to contain the dog securely. It could lead to potential injury affecting the safety and welfare of the dogs. The licensee must keep facilities in good repair to protect the animals from injury and contain the animals securely. Correct by 4/28/15.

PRIMARY ENCLOSURES.

* Protruding wires with sharp points were extending upwards from the enclosure flooring in one enclosure. One dog was in contact with the affected flooring located in sheltered housing. Sharp points could injure the dogs. The licensee must repair or replace all affected wiring to ensure the safety and welfare of the dogs. Correct by 4/28/15.
