ATTENDING VETERINARIAN AND ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE (DEALERS AND EXHIBITORS).

* No expiration date was recorded on one bottle containing Cephalexin pills. This medication was intermingled with other products that are currently being used at the facility and is therefore ready for use. This medication was obtained from the attending veterinarian. Medications must be labeled with appropriate and accurate information to ensure that the contents of the container can be known with certainty. The effectiveness and expected results could be drastically changed or may not work as anticipated if the expiration date is unknown. The usage of any medication with an unknown expiration date on regulated animals is not considered to be an acceptable veterinary practice and does not constitute adequate veterinary care. The licensee must ensure that all medications used in the facility have a current expiration date recorded. Correct by 5/25/15.

* The following medication used to treat the dogs at the facility was past the labeled expiration date. The recorded expiration date on one bottle containing Metronidazole 250 mg pills was 11/2013. This medication was intermingled with other products that are currently being used at the facility and is therefore ready for use. The usage of expired drugs on regulated animals is not considered to be an acceptable veterinary practice and does not constitute adequate veterinary care. The effectiveness of the dosage level and expected results when expired drugs are administered could be drastically changed or may not work as anticipated. The licensee must ensure that all medications used on the dogs have not gone past the recorded expiration date. Correct by 5/25/15.

HOUSING FACILITIES, GENERAL.

* Five galvanized metal gates and three galvanized metal divider panels are showing excessive rust. Eight dogs are in contact with the affected areas located in sheltered housing. The surfaces were rough in appearance. Rust can erode and deteriorate all metal surfaces to the point that the metal surfaces can no longer be readily cleaned and sanitized. Excessive rust affects the structural integrity of all metal surfaces. The licensee must ensure that this and all other surfaces are free of rust and of good structural strength. Correct by 6/11/15.
