#### ATTENDING VETERINARIAN AND ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE (DEALERS AND EXHIBITORS).

Appropriate methods and adequate veterinary care must be put into place to ensure that all dogs receive proper dental care. Kitten, an older red and white Japanese Chin, identification number #38, needs her teeth addressed by a licensed veterinarian. The left side of her mouth, her teeth are abnormal shaped, brown with a buildup of tartar or plaque. The top gum appear to be receding. Kittens, right side, her cheek teeth and k-9 tooth are brown and stained. Her top gum appears to be receding, also. This could be painful and lead to poor eating habits. The owner must have this dog seen by a veterinarian to determine what best dental procedure needs to be done for this dog. A plan needs to be in place to actively address older dogs in this area. An efficient dental care program will help dogs to be healthy and maintain a good body score for their older years. Correct by 09-02-2017.
