2.75(a)(2) Repeat

Records: Dealers and exhibitors.

The facility is not using APHIS Form 7006 (Record of Disposition of Dogs and Cats) to document the sale of the kittens. APHIS Form 7006 must be used in order to ensure that all required disposition information is documented and available for inspection.

Each dealer shall use APHIS Form 7006 (Record of Disposition of Dogs and Cats) to make, keep, and maintain the required disposition information. The licensee must use APHIS Form 7006 to record the disposition (sale, donation, or trade) of all adult cats and kittens and ensure these records are available for inspection.

3.1(e) Repeat

Housing facilities, general.

There are 4 bags of unopened cat food stored on the floor of the housing facility. Bags of food stored directly on the floor could become spoiled or contaminated should they come into contact with spilled water. Bags stored on the floor can also interfere with cleaning of the facility which could attract pests such as insects and rodents.

Unopened bags of food must be stored off the floor and away from walls to allow for cleaning and to protect the food from contamination and spoilage. The licensee must store the 4 bags of food off the floor and ensure that all unopened bags of food are stored compliantly at all times.

At least 1 open bag of cat food was found in the housing facility, and one open bag of cat food was found in the kitten room. Open bags of food could become contaminated by pests such as insects or rodents.

Open bags of food must be stored in a leakproof container with a tightly fitting lid to protect the food from contamination. The licensee must place these bags of open food into containers with tightly fitting lids and ensure all open bags of food are stored compliantly at all times.

Inspection Report

One enclosure, containing 1 adult cat and 5 kittens, does not have an elevated resting surface. Failure to provide an elevated resting surface does not allow a cat to exhibit its normal behaviors of jumping and/or climbing and limits the space available for the cats to move away from each other.

Each primary enclosure housing cats must contain an elevated resting surface. The licensee must add an elevated resting surface to the enclosure and ensure each enclosure contains a compliant elevated resting surface(s) at all times.
