ATTENDING VETERINARIAN AND ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE (DEALERS AND EXHIBITORS).

* There were four vials of Feline Rhinotracheitis Calici-Panleukopenia with an expiration date of 06/15. These vaccines were found intermingled with other vaccines in the refrigerator and are therefore considered ready for use. The usage of expired medical materials on regulated animals is not considered to be an acceptable veterinary practice. Expired medications and vaccines can experience spoilage or have reduced efficacy. This could result in decreased immunity for the animals being vaccinated. The licensee must ensure that all vaccines/medications used at the facility have not gone past the recorded expiration date. Correct by 10/15/15.

* The current program of veterinary care(PVC) stated that the non human primate (NHP) was under the care of another veterinarian. The licensee stated that she had a PVC signed by another veterinarian specific for the NHP but she was unable to find it during the inspection. It is important that the NHP is included in a written PVC to ensure she is receiving adequate veterinary care. The licensee must ensure that the program of veterinary care covers all species being housed at the facility. The program of veterinary care must be made available for review during inspections to ensure adequate veterinary care is being provided. Correct by 10/15/15.

FACILITIES, GENERAL.

* The plexi glass surrounding the indoor enclosure housing five rabbits was broken in two different areas. In addition, a sharp edge was observed where the plexi glass was broken allowing access to the welded wire with sharp points behind the plexi glass. Sharp edges could injure the animals. The licensee must ensure that all enclosures are maintained in good repair to protect the animals from injury. Correct by 10/15/15.
