The licensee acquired 1 cat hybrid on 6/1/13, & 3 cat hybrids on 6/9/13 from two different sources. These acquisitions were the only ones in the past year that were from non USDA licensed individuals.

In each of these acquisitions, the licensee did not obtain the driver's license number AND vehicle tag number from the persons from whom these cats were acquired. The licensee also could not locate the addresses of these individuals during the inspection.

For all acquisitions from non USDA licensed individuals you must obtain that person's, address, driver's license number and state, and the vehicle tag number and state.

HOUSING FACILITIES, GENERAL.

The upper portion of enclosure # 4 in the front cat area has chicken wire that is overlaid onto other wire mesh. This chicken wire has deteriorated and is broken in many areas creating numerous sharp points that potentially can injure the cats.

The cats in this enclosure do climb and have contact with this chicken wire.

All enclosures shall be maintained in good repair the protect the animals from injury.

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CLEANING, SANITIZATION, HOUSEKEEPING, AND PEST CONTROL.

The surrounding grounds where the front cat enclosures are located has a very large accumulation of feces from several different species of animals.

These accumulations can, and do, attract flies (especially during the summer months), as well as vermin and do not facilitate the prescribed husbandry practices that are required.

Premises where housing facilities are located, including surrounding grounds, must be kept clean to facilitate the prescribed husbandry practices that are required, as well as to reduce other pests and vermin.

Correct by July 26, 2014

The exit interview was conducted on-site with the licensee. The licensee was made aware of the above non compliances at that time.
