SANITATION.

There is one plastic cage that contained 1 hedgehog ("Nebula"). This cage is covered with a plastic lid containing several ventilation holes. When the lid was removed for inspection, a strong ammonia odor was present. The amount of odor was sufficient to cause irritation of the inspector's respiratory tract.

This cage shall be cleaned more frequently than the other cages (which are uncovered), or redesigned, so that ammonia does not build up within the cage. Excreta shall be removed from primary enclosures as often as necessary to prevent contamination of the animals contained therein and to minimize disease hazards and to reduce odors.
