Cleaning, sanitization, housekeeping, and pest control.

Two enclosures suspended four feet from the ground, and each housing a pair of blue and gold macaws, have an excessive accumulation of feces and food waste on the ground beneath them. There are also black streaks along the wall, beneath the enclosure on the right, that appear to be fecal material.

Accumulation of feces and food waste can lead to increased disease hazards or illnesses, cause odors, and attract pests.

Excreta and food waste must be removed from primary enclosures and from under and around primary enclosures as often as necessary to prevent excessive accumulation of feces and food waste, to prevent soiling of the birds contained in the primary enclosures, and to reduce disease hazards, insects, pests, and odors.
