Records: Dealers and exhibitors.

The facility maintains computerized acquisition and disposition records instead of APHIS Form 7005 (Record of Acquisition and Dogs and Cats on Hand) and APHIS Form 7006 (Record of Disposition of Dogs and Cats) but does not have an approved variance.

Utilizing computerized records without a variance does not allow APHIS to review the recordkeeping system prior to its approval to ensure it is comparable to required forms 7005 and 7006.

Each dealer shall use Record of Acquisition and Dogs and Cats on Hand (APHIS Form 7005) and Record of Disposition of Dogs and Cats (APHIS Form 7006) to make, keep, and maintain the information required by paragraph (a)(1) of this section: Provided, that if a dealer who uses a computerized recordkeeping system believes that APHIS Form 7005 and APHIS Form 7006 are unsuitable for him or her to make, keep, and maintain the information required by paragraph (a)(1) of this section, the dealer may request a variance from the requirement to use APHIS Form 7005 and APHIS Form 7006.

The facility provided a verbal plan for exercise for the dogs but does not have written document of the plan to provide dogs with opportunity for exercise. Without this plan, the facility may not be providing exercise for dogs as required by paragraph 3.8. It is necessary to allow the dogs the opportunity to exercise for their health and well being. A documented and approved exercise plan helps ensure that a dogs' space requirements and exercise needs have been considered and will be provided.

The facility must develop, document, and follow an appropriate plan to provide dogs with the opportunity for exercise. In

Veterinary care for dogs.

There was no written program of veterinary care for dogs available for review. The facility has a schedule for vaccination and veterinary visits but did not have anything documented in writing signed by the veterinarian.

Without an established and written program of veterinary care, USDA cannot assess the level of veterinary care, prevention, and treatment plans of the dogs in the kennel.

Each dealer must follow an appropriate program of veterinary care for dogs that is developed, documented in writing, and signed by the attending veterinarian and must keep and maintain the written program and make it available for APHIS inspection.
