2.78(a)

Health certification and identification.

One adult male common marmoset was accepted for consignment without proof of a health certificate. Health certificates are important for ensuring that animals are healthy, fit for travel and appear free of any infectious disease or physical abnormality that would be a danger to themselves, other animals, and the public. A health certificate issued by a licensed veterinarian, dated not more than 10 days prior to the transportation, must accompany all non-human primates. Correct from this date forward on Sept. 5, 2025.

3.87(a)(3)

Primary enclosures used to transport nonhuman primates.

One (1) adult male common marmoset and one (1) juvenile vervet were housed in travel-style pet crates for their transport enclosures. The openings of the door (approx. 1x1 inch square) and ventilation openings along the sides were big enough to allow the nonhuman primates to extend their arms and other body parts outside the transport enclosure. While the vervet had soft mesh placed on the outside of the enclosure, the animal was still able to reach through the openings of the enclosure and was pulling the mesh inside.

Openings large enough for nonhuman primates to extend parts of its body through can lead to injury of the nonhuman primates or to other animals or people nearby.

Primary enclosures used to transport nonhuman primates must be constructed so that the nonhuman primates are at all times securely contained within the enclosure and cannot put any body parts outside the enclosure in a way that could result in injury to the animals, or to persons or animals nearby.

3.137(d)

Primary enclosures used to transport live animals.

Several transport enclosures housing animals did not contain any litter or suitable absorbent material to absorb and cover excreta. One enclosure housing seven (7) juvenile mountain coatis contained litter but it was soaked, had excreta present and was sticking to the feet of the coatis and to the enclosure door. One enclosure housing two (2) adult mongoose was

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lacking clean litter in sufficient quantity to absorb and cover excreta. There was evidence of liquid on the floor of the enclosure that had not been absorbed.

Lack of absorbent litter or material to cover excreta and wastes can cause skin/coat contamination, distress, and increased risk of disease. Animals must be provided with clean litter of a suitable absorbent material that can absorb and cover excreta.
