Without records which fully disclose the animal's acquisition/disposition, legal and medical information traceback is not possible. Be consistent in maintaining records disclosing the required acquisition/disposition information including the date, name, address, and USDA number if applicable of the person from whom the animal was acquired from or transferred to. To be corrected by February 1, 2023.
