ATTENDING VETERINARIAN AND ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE (DEALERS AND EXHIBITORS).

- An adult female camel was observed with a broken halter fastened only around her neck. The halter was no longer over her nose or behind her ears. The halter hung from the neck creating a loop which could become hooked on fencing, trees, or other objects. At the time of the inspection, there had been no attempt to remove the broken halter from this animal. The licensee stated the halter had been that way for about a week. All animals must be observed daily for problems of animal health. These problems must be frequently and directly addressed to best provide for their health and well-being. The licensee must observe animals daily for problems.

FACILITIES, GENERAL.

- There are numerous sharp points and sharp edges in various locations on the facility. In the lower corner of the large barn enclosure area there is not a fence post in the corner and the cattle panels present have long exposed sharp points. The cross fence in the pasture where 14 camels are housed has many broken wires, holes and sharp points. The three sided structure for the camels has sharp edges on each side of the entrance. Sharp points and edges have the potential to injure the enclosed animals. All sharp points/edges must be removed or replaced
