ATTENDING VETERINARIAN AND ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE (DEALERS AND EXHIBITORS).

.A brown and light tan Yorkshire terrier female named Mandy id# (0A02031343) had hair loss around both eyes. The area appeared reddened as if she may have been scratching or rubbing the areas around both eyes. Skin irritation can be uncomfortable for the dog, left untreated the irritation could lead to more serious skin condition. Additionally, the top of her teeth have a brownish black substance on the top of most of her teeth. The gums are reddened and swollen. Two teeth behind the right top canine tooth have a grayish film on them and the gum has a white buildup along the top of the teeth. The back teeth also appeared to be covered with the brownish material. Gum infection can lead to loss of teeth and other serious, and painful health problems for the dog. Owner must take the dog to a licensed veterinary for evaluation and recommendations from the veterinarian. To be corrected by 10-23-2016

ATTENDING VETERINARIAN AND ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE (DEALERS AND EXHIBITORS).

A brown and white Chihuahua male named Pedro id#002165062 around eight years old. Pedro had a missing teeth and a buildup of grayish brown material around the top of his teeth then gum didn't appear to be reddened but the teeth need to have some of the material removed to protect the health of the dog. The buildup of material on the teeth can lead to more health problems in the future if not treated. Pedro's left eye also appeared to be dry and dull. There was no discharge from the eye it seem dry. Eye problems can be painful for the dog and must be treated as soon as possible to prevent further damage to the eye. Owner must take the dog to the veterinary for evaluation by 10-25-2016.

Kiki a black and tan Yorkshire terrier female named Kiki id# 13821401. Kiki toenail were overgrown enough that they affected her normal posture, the long nails caused her toes to turn when she walks, not normal for the dog. Longs nails can be uncomfortable for the dogs and can cause long term problems in the dog feet and toes. Licensee must maintain all the dogs toenails on a regular basis. HOUSING FACILITIES, GENERAL.

The inside of the regular kennel building had several areas where the dogs have chewed through the wall covering. Some of the kennels have been sealed and repaired. Two enclosures with dog in the them had holes in the paneling on the walls. All surfaces the dogs are in contact with must be impervious to moisture and be easily cleaned and sanitized. The kennels walls must be maintained, cleaned and sanitized to prevent spread of disease and other vermin that can adversely affect the health and well-being of the dogs. One outdoor enclosure containing a Rhodesian ridgeback did not have adequate shade. The shade cloth was not large enough to provide adequate shade for the dog. The owner fixed the problem during the inspection.
