-- Three open bags of Small Animal Diet was sitting in the back food storage area along with open containers of hay and sawdust that is used for the guinea pigs. Improper storage may result in the food supply to spoil or become infested or contaminated by vermin. Supplies of food and bedding shall be stored in facilities which adequately protect such supplies against spoilage or deterioration and infestation or contamination by vermin. Food supplies shall be stored in containers with tightly fitting lids or covers or in the original containers as received from the commercial source. Provide food which is wholesome, palatable, and free from contamination to maintain all animals in good health at all times.
